



CompetitionEntry Fees

InterschoolsAustraliaRegistrationand Administration Fee:EachstudententeringInterschoolseventsis required to pay a once-only registration and administration fee of approximately\$55. This fee covers event insurance administration costs for the Regional State and National Championshipsin 2024, this fee will also include an Oxleyhelmet cover for students competing in downhill events or an Oxleybuff for students only competing in cross country events. This fee will be added to your school account.

Racœntry: In 2024, the evententry feesare \$55 per event, per competitor at each Championship Race entry fees do not include a student's lift pass. These fees will be added to your school account.

Lift PassesStudent'scompetingin the downhill eventsmust have a valid lift passfor eachday they are competing. Lift passesmust be purchased separately, as this is not a service the school can offer. Lift passes are not required for crosscountry events.

Team Selection

All students are able to compete as individuals within their events (with the exception of Cross Country Relay, which is a team event only). Where possible and numbers allow, Oxleywill endeavour to place students within teams, in order to compete as a team as well. From 2024, Moguls will be an event for individuals only and team selection does not apply.

DoesSnowsportsinterfere with other winter sports at Oxley?

The Regional Interschools event is held Tuesday Friday during school holidays and does not interfere with any school sport.

The State Championships held during term time Monday-Friday. This would not impact a student's ability to competeon Saturday but may affect their ability to attend training for another sport that week. An exemption from training will be provided that week.

The National Championship is held in September. This is usually after the completion of the ISA winter seasor and should not impact Senior School students. The event may impact some Junior School students' attendance at training that week and would not impact game attendance. An exemption for training will be provided for that week.
